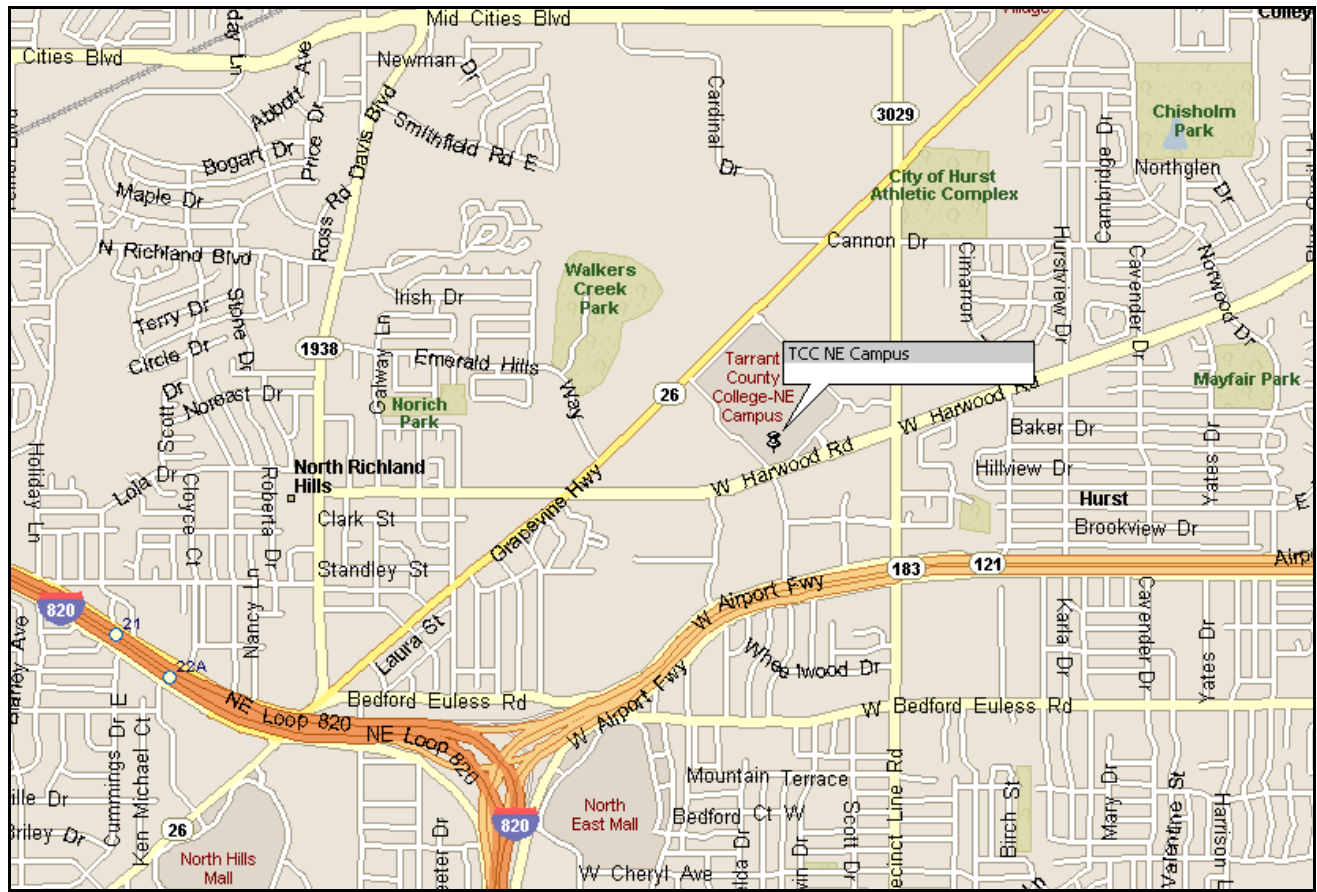

## Fine Arts Building

A few things to remember:

- You should park in the lot at the North-East intersection of Harwood and Campus Drive. The Fine Arts building is in the North-East corner of that lot.
- Be sure to bring your music (although I will be there with a clean score as well).
- Be sure to have played some that day before you arrive.
- Arrive at least 15-20 minutes early.
- You should be completely finished within 30 minutes of your *arrival* – about 10 minutes after you play.
- Be sure to **“practice performing”** (at least three times each day) in order to help you prepare for the performance. Remember you only have one chance to play straight through the piece, and that is the performance that the judge must grade you by. So you must be familiar with what it feels like to perform the piece.

*Also remember that if you receive a Superior+ rating, you will be invited to perform on one of the Honors Recitals the evening of Monday, April 7<sup>th</sup> (exact time TBA). I will request that you perform on the later concert. This concert is at the same location but in a building just across from the music building.*
